- Understand the favor given to a well-rounded job candidate (the importance of extracurricular activities, volunteerism, etc.)

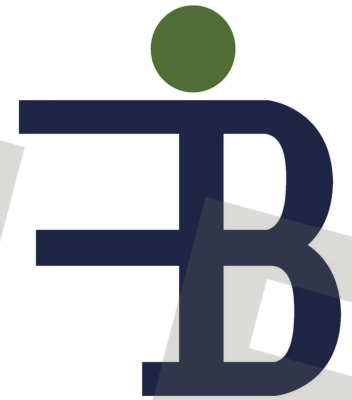
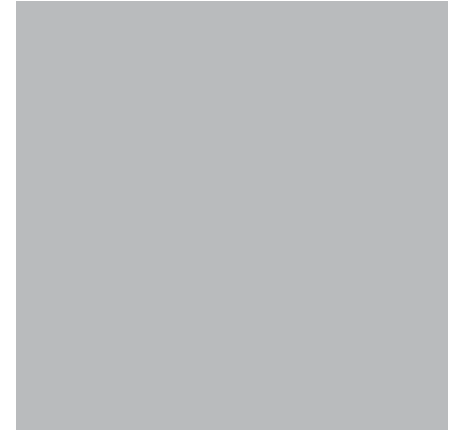

- good at convincing others to try a product or service.

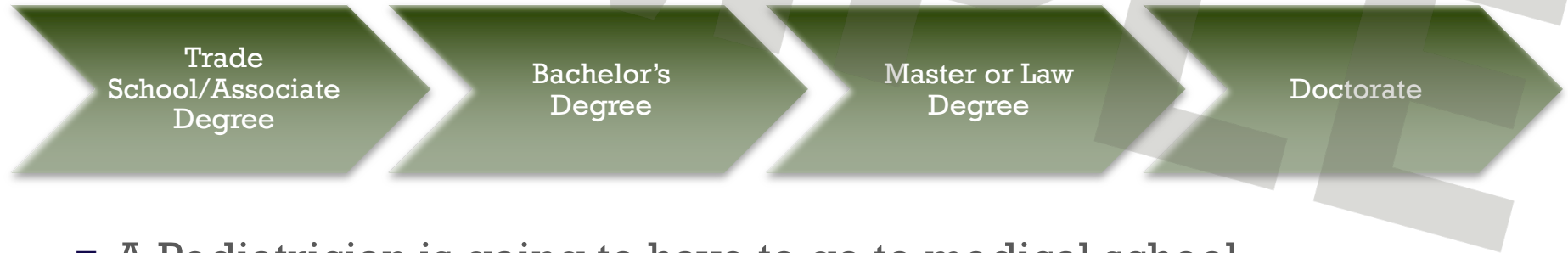

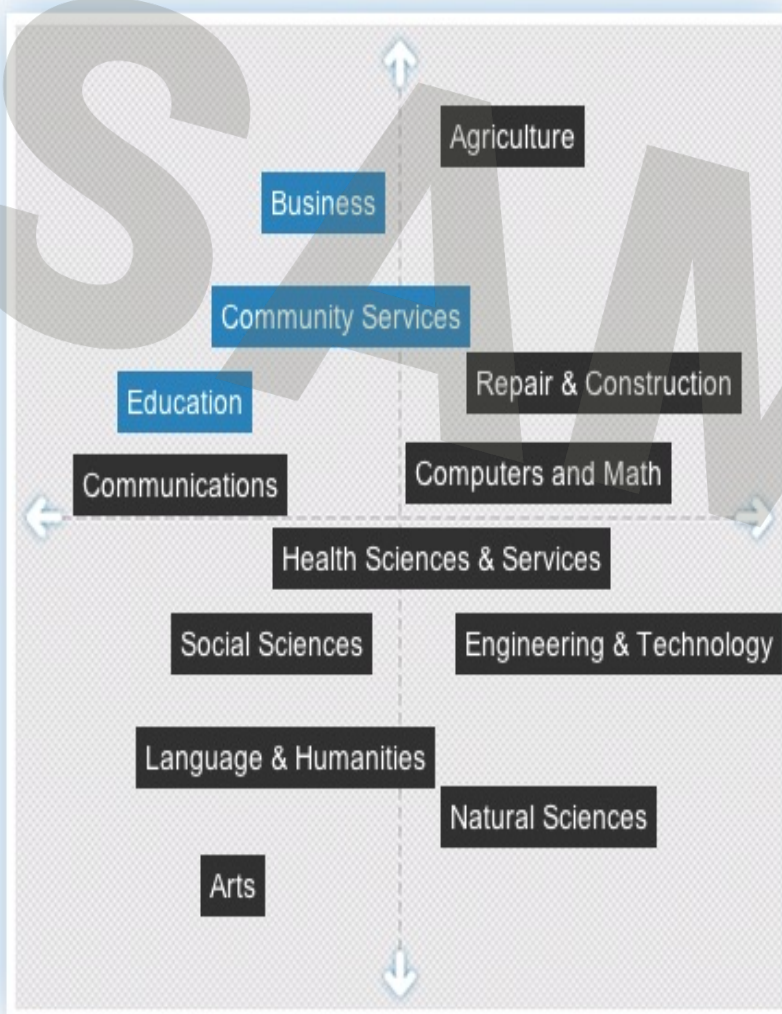
- School has been “your job”

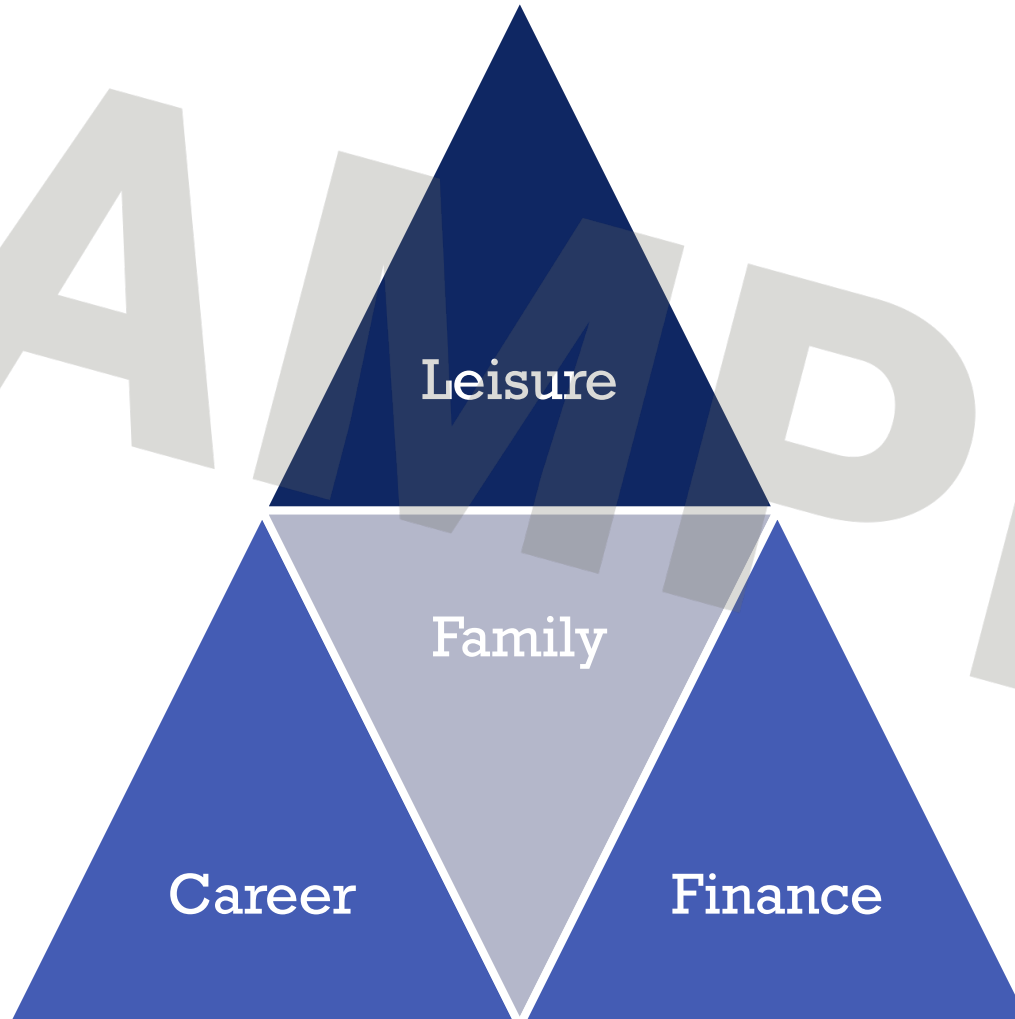
